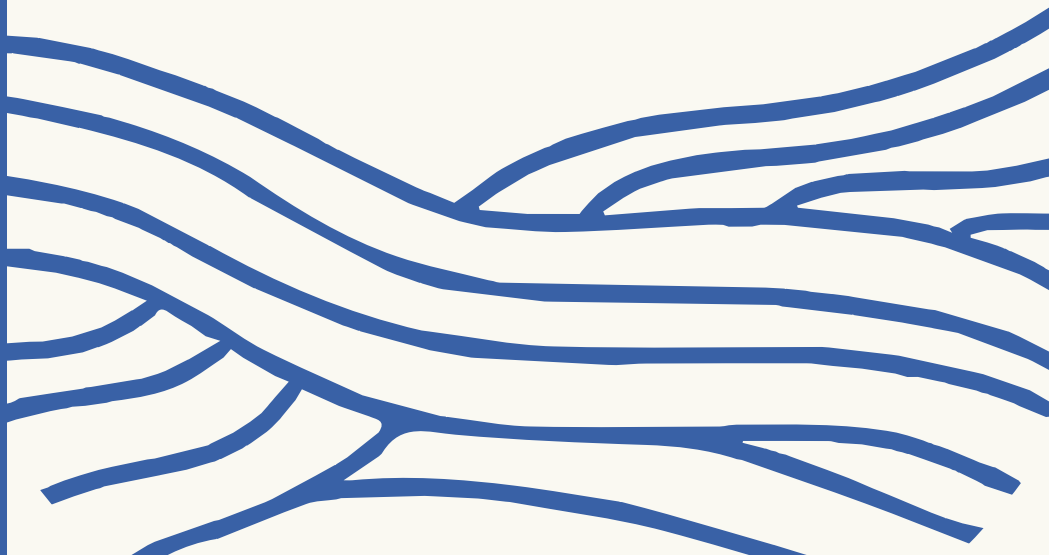

LearnU: Budgeting Basics was the first program delivered under the LearnU initiative and was held in person at the Stone Mountain Sue Kellogg Library on October 24, 2025. Content was presented through guided slides, real-life examples, and open discussion. Participants followed along during the session and completed their own personal budget worksheet to take home.
